GARBAGE REMOVAL BYLAW**

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF NAMPA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO  
SET THE RATES FOR GARBAGE REMOVAL IN THE VILLAGE OF NAMPA**

**WHEREAS** Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act R.S.A. 2000 c.M-26 provides that a Council may pass bylaws respecting services provided by or on behalf of the municipality.

**AND WHEREAS**, Council deems it necessary to increase garbage rates which are presently in effect in the Village of Nampa. That the charge for garbage pickup shall be:

Each residence in the Village of Nampa shall be charged \$16.00 for a one-month period.

There shall be no charge to a business as they are responsible to make arrangements with the garbage disposal companies to rent a bin or look after their own garbage removal.

This Bylaw shall repeal Bylaw # 433 and shall come into force and effect when it receives third reading and is duly signed.
