Being a Bylaw of the Village of Nampa
In the Province of Alberta

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF NAMPA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER AND TO OUTLINE THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

WHEREAS Section 206 of the Municipal Government Act of Province of Alberta provides that a municipal council must by Bylaw establish the position of Chief Administrative Officer.

WHEREAS Section 207 and 208 of the Municipal Government Act of the Province of Alberta provides that the Chief Administrative Officer shall exercise the powers and duties set out in the Municipal Government Act, and such other powers and duties as may be voted, confirmed or delegated by Bylaw, or resolution of council.

AND WHEREAS council deem it proper to expedient to establish the position of Chief Administrative Officer and define the duties, responsibility and authority thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NAMPA DULY ASEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
