A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF NAMPA IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY FOR THE TAXATON YEAR **2021**.

WHEREAS, the Village of Nampa has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the council meeting held on November 12, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the Village of Nampa for 2021 total \$ 1,561,782.48; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation is estimated at \$ 1,110,388.49 and the balance of \$ 451,393.99 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and
